Make learning engaging

- Ask probing questions
- Share perspectives from the field
- Create weekly videos (students and instructors)



Give frequent feedback

- Emphasize ways to improve
- Give feedback students can use for their next task
- Share rubrics



Use multiple communication channels

- Use announcements and email
- Use a live session and a Q&A discussion board
- Provide individual and whole-class feedback



Be present in your online class

- Join your class on multiple days
- Respond within 24 hours
- Offer office hours
- Consider adding a text (SMS) option to your class



Create a supportive learning environment

- Monitor and moderate the class climate
- Connect and relate with students
- Build community
